What do we do?

Ian has always worked in Bible Translation and translated the Tampilma Bible which was dedicated in 2000. Many people came to know the Lord through the reading of the Scriptures in their own language and the Bibles quickly sold out. Now Ian and Pastor Samuel Asare are presently revising the Tampilma Bible specially as the young people are asking for their Bible.

Claire has always been involved in teaching the people to read and with her Ghanaian colleague Nelson has literacy classes and Bible studies in over a thousand churches. She is also involved in many projects helping the people with school fees, radio preaching, cataracts, cows, goats and sheep, and salaries for the national translators.

It is hard to believe we have worked in Africa specially in Ghana for 50 years. Ian has always been involved with Bible translation and the past 15 years checking other Bibles from 10 different languages.

The Gona Bibles have now arrived safely in Ghana and the date for the Gona dedication will Saturday 17th February 2011. We are very much looking forward to their big day and seeing our Gona translators and friends again.
